REESE HIGGINS TOOK ROLL CALL AS SECRETARY LILIANA WAS ABSENT FROM THE MEETING. HAPPY ROCK HAD TWO MEMBERS AND ONE ADULT, FOLSOM HAD FIVE MEMBERS AND THREE ADULTS, MT DORA HAD FIVE KIDS AND TWO ADULTS, AND ROCK N RIDE HAD THREE KIDS AND ONE ADULT. 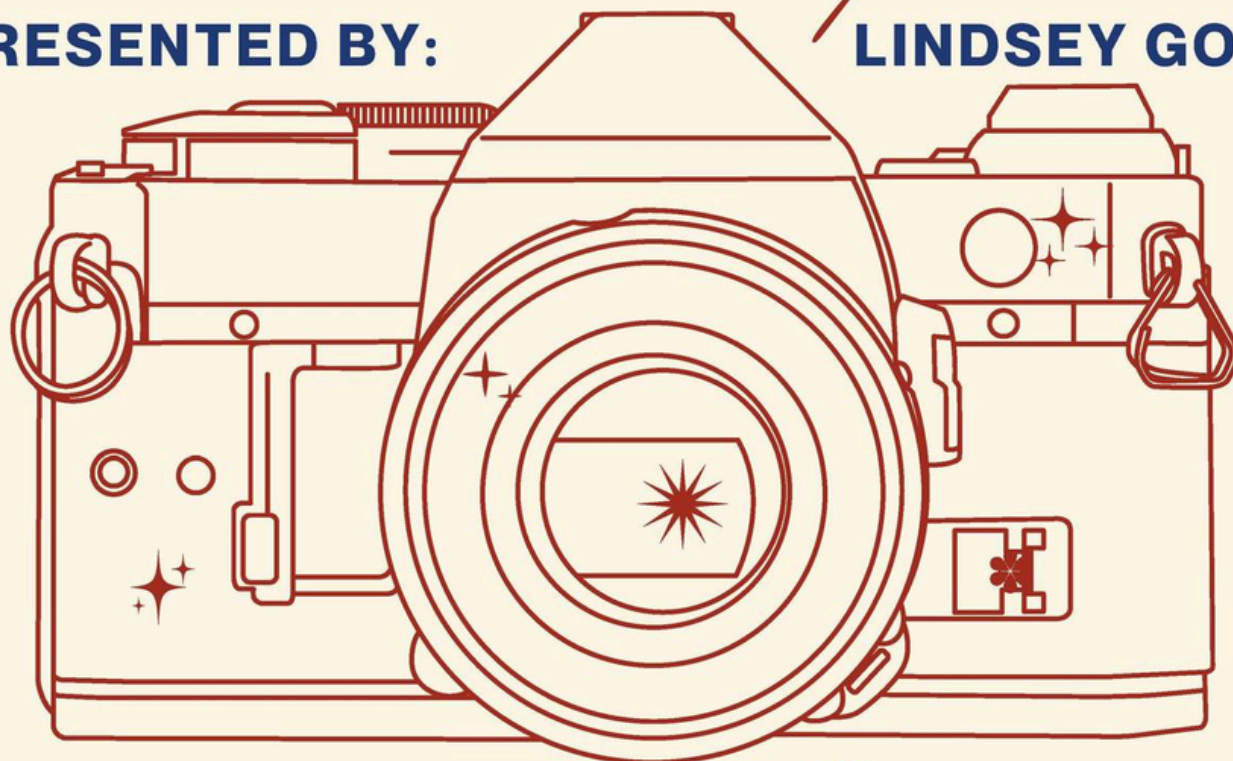
