

In order to compete at county, district, and state contests you must attend 2 practices and must participate at county contest(unless otherwise stated).

Union County Shooting Sports Code of Conduct Form 2024/2025

The 4-H member must read, sign, and return this form to the Extension Office.

1.	Know and obey all range commands.		
2.	Guns and magazines are to be unloaded except when on the firing line, ready to fire.		
3.	Arrows will not be knocked until on the firing line.		
4.	All .22 rifles and shotguns must have a safety device. Muzzleloaders will remain uncapped until the firing line. The safety will remain on, or in a safe condition, at all times except when ready to fire.		
5.	All firearms will be pointed, and bows drawn in a safe direction at all times.		
6.	Actions of uncased firearms must always be open except when on the firing line, ready to fire.		
7.	Only one shell or cartridge may be placed in a gun at a time, unless otherwise specified in the rules for the activity.		
8.	Participants/Observers must wear adequate eye and ear protection while on the firing line. Closed toed shoes are mandatory. No sandals, flip flops, or crocs.		
9.	All 4-Hers, parents and guests should abide by the 4-H dress code requiring shorts that are mid-thigh in length, no spaghetti or strapless shirts, no mid-drifts showing, and no offensive sayings on the shirts. Jeans are to be worn for Rifle and Shotgun.		
10.	Respect the volunteer leaders and all adult. Pay attention when they are speaking, do not visit during instruction time, do not speak unkindly to adults, and by doing as you are asked.		
11.	The use of iPods and texting on cell phones will not be permitted during practices.


